2010 Jr. Coach Rules & Responsibilities

Bartlett Raiders Athletic Association, Inc. takes great pride in making sure our young girls receive the support and encouragement needed to succeed in cheerleading. Our cheerleaders deserve every opportunity to be the best that they can be which can be accomplished by the help of dedicated Coaches and Jr. Coaches. Therefore, the following rules have been implemented:

1. Jr. Coach applicants will be assigned to a team no later than June 7, 2010.
2. If there are applicants after June 7, 2010, and if there is still a vacancy on one of the top three requested teams, the junior will be placed accordingly. If not, they will be assigned to teams where the most help is needed.
3. ALL meetings are mandatory and will be arranged by the Head Coach or Cheer Director.
4. Once Jr. Coaches are assigned to a squad, they will receive a contact list of all coaches and Jr. Coaches. Jr. Coaches are then responsible for contacting one another to choreograph the competition routine.
5. The competition routine and music deadline is August 2, 2010 where the Cheer Director will listen to all music for approval and view the routine. Jr. Coaches should at minimum have the cheer, what stunts they would like to use, and 1/3 of the dance complete by this date.
6. The competition routine should be complete by August 16, 2010, but cheerleaders should start practicing the routine by the second week of practice.
7. If the music is not provided on August 2, 2010 then the Cheer Director will provide a pre-edit music cd and the Jr. Coaches will have until August 16, 2010 to choreograph a competition routine.
8. If the second deadline is not met, August 16, 2010, then the Cheer Director, Coaches, and the Bartlett Raiders Board must discuss further participation for Jr. Coach(es) as this is one of the major responsibilities for Jr. Coaches.
9. If a practice must be missed, the Head Coach must receive 24 hours notice. This is required so coaches will have time to make any necessary changes.

2010 Jr. Coach Rules & Responsibilities

- 10. Head Coaches will be taking attendance for all Jr. Coaches and have the right to discuss any attendance issues with the Cheer Director. It is important that Jr. Coaches attend all practices. We do understand that there are scheduling conflicts, but if it seems that more practices are missed than attended and the cheerleaders are not benefiting from the help of a Jr. Coach, then it will be discussed at that time with the Jr. Coach, Head Coach, and Cheer Director if the Jr. Coach should or should not continue coaching.
- 11. Games: games are mandatory for cheerleaders, but if there is more than one Jr. Coach on a team, games can be split between Jr. Coaches. This will allow for Jr. Coaches to attend their own weekend events. If there is only one Jr. Coach on a team, the Head Coach will work out a game schedule so that the Jr. Coach will be allotted the same opportunity as teams with more than one Jr. Coach.

Your participation is greatly needed and appreciated. These rules are not set to control Jr. Coaches, but to allow for a more organized program so that everyone can benefit from this experience. The Bartlett Raiders Cheer Program needs dependable and caring Jr. Coaches to help this cheer program grow.
